It plays a key role in reverse cholesterol transport (RCT), a process that transports cholesterol from peripheral tissues to liver metabolism. Apoa-I, a member of the apolipoprotein superfamily, is a cofactor of cholesterol lipoyltransferase (LCAT)
<b>Storage:</b>	Store at 4°C short term and -20°C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.
