Description:

Heparin-binding protein (HBP), also known as Azurocidin or cationic antibacterial protein (CAP37), is a multifunctional protein with bactericidal function and chemotactic characteristics, mainly existing in secretory granules and Azurocidin granules of neutrophils. Heparin binding protein is the earliest marker of bacterial infection. When infection occurs, bacteria invade into blood vessels and stimulate neutrophils to release HBP, which increases plasma HBP content.
